





Lord Stirling Park


General William Alexander, known as “**Lord Stirling**,” was one of the Revolutionary War’s most intriguing figures. His grand estate once stood in today’s **Lord Stirling Park in Basking Ridge** and was among the most impressive homes in colonial America. Somerset County is now working with archaeologists to uncover hidden remains of the original site and share its story.

Looking Out for Revolution

Washington Valley Park’s Eagle’s Nest is a historic Revolutionary War lookout once used by **General George Washington** during the Middlebrook encampments. This scenic hilltop also **featured a fire beacon designed by “Lord Stirling”** to warn nearby towns and troops. Today, Somerset County is improving access, trails, and interpretive features to help visitors better experience this powerful historic site.

A Bridge to the Past

The Old Stone Arch Bridge is believed to be **the oldest bridge in New Jersey and one of the oldest of its kind in the country**. Built as early as 1731, it played a key role in colonial travel and the **1777 Battle of Bound Brook** before being buried and preserved beneath modern roads for decades. Now owned by Somerset County, plans are underway to highlight the bridge’s remarkable history through future interpretation and a small park setting.

Known as the Crossroads of the American Revolution, New Jersey played a major part in the Revolutionary War and **Somerset County was at the heart of it.** While in Somerset County, George Washington and four of his top generals headquartered at nearby houses that are known today as **SOMERSET COUNTY'S FIVE GENERALS HOUSES:**

- 1 Van Veghten House (Bridgewater)
- 2 Philip Van Horne House (Bridgewater)
- 3 Wallace House & Old Dutch Parsonage (Somerville)
- 4 Jacobus Vanderveer House (Bedminster)
- 5 Abraham Staats House (South Bound Brook)

The Olympic Training Center and headquarters at Hamilton Farm. Individual visitors and groups are encouraged to visit at any time.







- Delaware & Raritan Canal (Multi)** - Over 70-miles of recreational corridor. The D&R Canal boasts a historic towpath set along rural sites
- Duke Farms (Hillsborough)** - A place of education and enjoyment. Visitors may explore 1,000+ acres of native species and the area's natural beauty. Bike rentals are available on-site during dedicated times. Designated as an Important Bird Area.
- Fairview Farms Wildlife Preserve (Bedminster)** - Miles of walking trails through meadows and woods, a scenic pond, colorful gardens, and a restored 1800s barn complex.
- Scherman Hoffman Wildlife Sanctuary (Bernardsville)** - The headquarters of New Jersey Audubon, SHWS has 276 acres of woodland, field, and floodplain that supports over 200 species of wildlife including 60+ species of nesting birds and 25 species of warblers during spring migration.
- Somerset County Park Commission Environmental Education Center (Basking Ridge)** - Located on 500 acres the facility has over 9 miles of trails
- Sourland Mountain Preserve (Hillsborough, Montgomery)** - 6,000+ acres of park with an undisturbed setting.
- Washington Valley Park and Hawk Watch Area (Bridgewater)** - 715-acre park of mixed hardwood forests, open freshwater wetland marshes, and rock outcroppings with a 21-acre reservoir. The Hawk Watch area is one of the East Coast's premier locations to watch raptors, hawks, falcons, eagles, ospreys, peregrine falcons, and more.
